Opening performance of NTNU Music Festival in March of every year	20 minutes-long performance. Taken at least 4 credits worth of courses under the Performance and Practice category, and also recommended by the course instructor	8-10 persons
Institute Public Concert in April of every year	60-70 minutes-long performance. Taken at least 2 credits worth of courses taught by the instructor responsible for the performance, and also recommended by said course instructor	10-15 persons
The Master's Thesis Presentation organized together with the Music Division of the Department of Music (master's or doctoral students) in May of every year	Selection will take on the form of an open call for papers. Students who are willing to participate in the event must submit a 300 to 500 word abstract for review. Every student has about 20 to 40 minutes to present and must participate in the entire event. 1. Thesis presenters must have taken the course Introduction to Ethnomusicology 2. Presenters of 10 to 15 minutes-long musical works (audio recording, video, creation, etc.) must have taken the course Theory and Practice of Music Dissemination	6-8 persons
Video recordings of public concerts of the Institute and the Department of Music every year	Participants must have taken the course Research on Digital Recording & Production, have been recommended by the course instructor, and be willing to fully cooperate with the recordings	8-10 persons
